- 2) A synopsis (max. 5 pages incl. list of references) in which you
 - a) Explain the relevance of the topic (personal interest/relevance of the research question),
 - b) formulate a concrete question within the topic area,
 - c) provide an overview of the literature you have already identified/relevant,
 - d) Outline your intended research design (survey & evaluation method) and
 - e) Make a preliminary resource/time planning.

We look forward to receiving your application! You will be informed as soon as possible whether you will be invited to an interview at the Weibel Chair.
